April 15, 2020, **WV reported 718 positive 17,821 Negative 12 deaths**

Grant County 1 positive case. Contacts are self-reporting. There has been some incorrect information reported apparently by the World.Health.Organization (W.H.O.)...By WV Law, positive cases of COVID-19 are reportable to the County Health Department. These are then sent to the State, which is reflected on the www.coronavirus.wv.gov (DHHR site). These numbers sometimes may be delayed on the DHHR site.

In Grant County, as the Public Information Officer, I report positive cases to the public as soon as I can confirm and talk with the patient, health care provider, and local officials.
